#### THE POSITION

**Public Works Utility Technician** - This is a full time, represented position that works under the direction of the Public Works Operations Managers. The job consists of performing the daily operations, maintenance, and repairs of the specific utility system(s) assigned, within the City's water, sewer, street, storm and parks departments.

#### THE IDEAL CANDIDATE

The ideal candidate will have multiple State of Oregon Water/Wastewater Operator Certifications. This person will be a self-motivated, independent learner, who can work effectively both individually and as part of a team. Work experience will include 2 years in public works or related field.

#### MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Minimum requirements include possession of a high school diploma or equivalent; valid Oregon CDL Class B. Applicant must maintain a residency requirement of a 30 minute response time. First-Aid/ CPR, confined space entry, and flagger certification, lockout/tagout training, and Self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) fit testing required within 6 month probationary period.

#### OUR COMMUNITY

The City of Monmouth, with a population of 11,655, is home to Western Oregon University. Centrally located in the Mid-Willamette Valley, Monmouth is 20 miles west of Salem, an hour from Portland to the north, and Eugene to the south. The Oregon Coast, and the Cascades are within an hour providing an abundance of recreation opportunities.

#### OUR DEPARTMENT

With a staff of 16 full time employees, the Public Works Department is responsible for the water, sewer, street, storm, and park departments. The water department consists of 4 wells, 4 reservoirs, approximately 37 miles of water mains, and 3,041 metered service connections. The sewer department has 50 acres of treatment lagoons, an effluent reuse facility, 5 lift pump stations, and 22 miles of mainlines. The Public Works Department also maintains 35 miles of streets, 14.5 miles of storm lines, and 25 acres of parkland.
